Tours at Filoli take children into California's gold, water and shipping past. This beautifully-preserved Georgian Revival country place estate with world-class gardens and over 600 acres of nature preserve is a living reminder of a way of life that is all but lost. Filoli tells the story of respect for place - how stewardship and preservation of a community treasure can link us to the past.

What is Filoli?

Once the home of the Bourns (1917-1936) and the Roths (1936-1975), today Filoli is an historic home, garden, and nature preserve owned by the National Trust for Historic Preservation.
