

MATERIALS LIST

Botanical Art 2012

Graphite Pencil I & II

Note: The first three items can be found in the drafting section of art supply stores and some office supply stores. They are also available online: download the on-line sources document for more information.

- **Lead holder:** Some manufacturers are Koh-I-Noor and Staedtler Mars, for example. (This is what draftsmen used before the advent of computers.)
- **Leads:** 2 mm slim cylinders of graphite to fit into holder: H, F, HB and another B of your choice. (*Note: The lead holder and leads are not the same as “mechanical pencils”.07 or .05 lead refills.*)
- **Lead pointer:** For sharpening leads; use either handheld or clamp-on table model.
- **Eraser:** Pentel “Clic”
- **X-acto knife:** Any blade at all, to be used to trim “Clic” eraser to a chisel point.
- **Tracing paper** – A couple of pieces, 9” x 12” or so; quality doesn’t matter.
- **Draftsman’s Duster or any soft, wide brush:** For brushing erasures off drawing.
- **Paper Support:** Use a clipboard or a piece of foam core larger than your paper. I use a standard 18” x 18” clipboard that comes with a wide rubber band to help hold the paper in place.

The instructor will provide the paper: Strathmore Series 500 plate-surface and semi-smooth surface 2-ply Bristol papers.
