Dear Students,

There are lots of right answers. We're looking for variety so whatever fabric and ribbon pleases you will be great. Avoid papery/non-woven florists' ribbon if possible. The supplies listed are minimums. The more the merrier! Bring alternative materials that interest you. Be experimental. See you soon! - *Candace*

TOOLS

- scissors for silk
- scissors for wire ribbon & paper
- ball head pins
- needles and thread
- 2" hair clippies, not barrettes (try a beauty supply or drug store)
- 6" embroidery hoop (or bring what you have)
- tape measure
- notebook and pencil/pen (2 colors)
- folder for 8 ½ x 11 handouts

SUPPLIES

- 8 yards wire-edged ribbon, 1½" wide
- 6 yards wire-edged ribbon, 1" wide, some flower colored
- 4 yards ribbon, ¼" (soft baby ribbon or ribbon for silk ribbon embroidery)
- 1 yard of fabric, luscious but not too soft. Think of substituting silk scarves or a thrift store garment
- 2 yards of 2 ½" Hanah Silk (china or charmeuse) or fabric bias strips, flower colored
