Botanical Art: Colored Pencil Classes 2011

- Pad of drawing paper, Strathmore 400 series or something similar, 11 x 14-good quality and one sheet of Fabriano **Hot Press** Watercolor paper (140lb.) cut into four pieces which the instructor will provide for sale in class.
- Tracing Paper (9 x 12 is fine)
- Kneaded eraser
- Graphite drawing pencils, 2H or HB
- Hand held pencil sharpener and something for shavings (the little gold 'pineapple' types are the best)

Colored Pencils:

If you have a set of good quality colored pencils (Prismacolors, Lyra, Derwent, Faber-Castell) bring them. Otherwise, it is better to buy the pencils we need individually. If you **already own** watercolor pencils bring them. We may get a chance to play with them. You will need the following basic colors. You can mix and match brands. They all play well together. **Please sharpen pencils before class.**

Prismacolors: available almost everywhere individually	Faber-Castell (also highly recommended, available individually at www.dickblick.com .They continually change the names of their pencils so look for the numbers.

Yellow Ochre or any of the Ochres that Faber-Castell offers	
Prismacolor Verithins for detail: Indigo, Tuscan Red, Olive green
