- Graphite pencils (various hardnesses)
- Pencil sharpener with reservoir for shavings
- Erasers (kneaded & white)
- Permanent, waterproof black ink pens (various sizes from .005-.08) Suggested brand: Micron
- Colored pencils (set of 12, the best you can afford)
- A small set of watercolor paints (again, the best you can afford)*
- 2 or 3 watercolor brushes (various sizes, depending on what sizes you wish to work with)
- Sketchbook (any size and paper type you are comfortable with)
- One or two sheets of Canson Mi Tientes paper in a neutral color (grey, blue, sage green, tan, etc.)**
- One sheet of 140 lb. watercolor paper, cut down to portable size (best quality paper you can afford, I prefer Arches)**
- Optional: Pentel waterbrush***
- Portable Stool
- Dress for the outdoors: layered clothing, closed-toe shoes, a hat and sunscreen.
- Bottled Water
- Optional: Camera

*If you do not want to buy a whole set of watercolor paints, I can make you a small set like my field sketching kit for a small fee. Please let me know if you are interested in this option by the end of the first class.

**If you do not want to buy a whole sheet of either of these papers, please let me know. I will buy some full sheets and cut them down so you can buy a piece or two directly from me.
